**Comment:**

Part of Council's decision from its Ordinary Council Meeting held on 2 October 2012 was to establish a formal agreement with the Water Corporation to define the responsibilities of both parties for the use of the land.

Upon investigation this agreement appears not to have been finalised and therefore any acceptance of responsibility for the maintenance of the infrastructure would require preparation of a formal agreement which is fair and reasonable and indemnifies each parties' interests for their own negligence.

**Officer's Recommendation:**

That Council:

1. Notes the request from Harvey Mainstreet for the Shire to consider taking on the care, control and management of the Harvey Diversion Enhancement Project Infrastructure.
2. Supports the request from the Harvey Mainstreet to accept the responsibility for the maintenance of the infrastructure subject to entering an agreement with the Water Corporation which is fair and reasonable and indemnifies each parties' interests for their own negligence.
3. Advises Harvey Mainstreet that it agrees to take on Harvey Diversion Enhancement Project Infrastructure, as shown in **Attachment 2**, at an estimated cost of \$4,000 per annum from the date of the signed agreement with the Water Corporation.
4. Ensures that additional funds are included in the Meridan Park annual grounds maintenance Budget allocation.
