Animals

Cats and dogs



All cats over 6 months of age must be sterilised, microchipped and registered.



All dogs over 3 months of age must be registered and microchipped.

Chickens

If you live in a residential area:

- You can keep a **maximum** of 12 ducks or chickens.
- You cannot keep roosters.
- You cannot keep turkeys, geese, peacocks and peahens.

Livestock

Livestock owners should make sure:



- Animals are kept within property boundaries.
- Fences and gates are properly maintained.

If you find wandering livestock, please contact the Rangers on **9729 0300**.

Bees

You must apply to the Shire to keep bees.



The number of hives allowed depends on the size of your property.
