



Policy 4.2.16 – Signs - Commonwealth, State and Local Government elections

1. Policy

That the erection of Commonwealth, State and Local Government election signs be permitted by Council, without the issue of a sign permit, provided that those signs comply with the following requirements:

- No sign is to be placed on public land;
- One (1) only sign is permitted per lot.
- Maximum size of sign to be .75m²;
- Signs may be erected four (4) weeks prior to the election date and must be removed within seven (7) days after the election day;
- No candidate, or party, may erect two (2) signs within 500m of each other, within the same street;
- Compliance with the appropriate provisions of Council's Local Law Relating to Signs and Other Advertising Devices 2007; and
- Subject to Main Roads WA approval for signs on main roads.
