Policy 4.2.14 – Signs – unlawfully displayed

1. Policy

Whenever unauthorised signs are found on road reserves, they are to be removed to the Council Depot where they will be retained for 10 days before being destroyed. During the 10-day retention period the owner of any such unauthorised sign may recover it upon payment of a fee set by Council and contained within the annual schedule of fees and charges. This policy provides the process to implement clause 35 of Local Law Relating to Signs and Billposting.
