

Policy 5.1.1 – Engineering Design and Construction Standards – Subdivisions

1. Policy Purpose

To inform subdivision developers, their Consultants and Contractors of the Shire of Harvey's decision to adopt the current version of the IPWEA's "Local Government – Guidelines for Subdivisional Development" as policy for subdivision development within the Shire.

2. Policy Scope

This policy applies to the design and construction of new subdivision development within the Shire.

3. Policy

Council adopts the current version of the IPWEA's "Local Government – Guidelines for Subdivisional Development" as policy for subdivision development within the Shire of Harvey. The Director Infrastructure Services (DIS) will periodically review the Guidelines for Subdivisional Development and where, in the opinion of the DIS, any changes required to meet the specific needs of the Shire, details will be submitted for Council's consideration.
