Please do not place organic material (food scraps and garden organics), recyclables and hazardous items in this bin.



Recycling Bin

Recycling bin is for all your recyclable items. Remove lids from bottles, empty and rinse containers. Keep it loose, don't bag your recyclables.

What can go in my Recycling Bin?

- Aluminium and steel cans
- Glass bottles and jars
- Magazines and paper
- Flattened cardboard
- Plastic bottles and containers

Please do not place plastic bags or wrap, clothes, nappies, aerosoles or gas bottles in this bin.
