Local Government Ordinary Election Close of Enrolments

Roll Close 5pm Friday, 27 August 2021

You may be eligible to be enrolled to vote in the local government elections on 16 October 2021 if you live in or are an owner or occupier of rateable property in the Shire of Harvey.

Residents - You are automatically enrolled to vote if you are on the State Electoral Roll as at 5pm Friday, 27 August 2021. If you are not already on the State Electoral Roll and meet the eligibility criteria, or if you have changed address recently, you must complete an enrolment form.

Enrolment Forms - Electoral enrolment forms are available from the Shire of Harvey, all Australian Electoral Commission offices (www.aec.gov.au) or the Western Australian Electoral Commission (www.elections.wa.gov.au) and must be completed and reach a Divisional Returning Officer in Western Australia by 5pm Friday, 27 August 2021.

Non-Resident Owners and Occupiers - If you are a non-resident owner or occupier of rateable property in the Shire of Harvey and are on the State or Commonwealth Electoral Roll, you are eligible to enrol to vote. If you are not on the State or Commonwealth Electoral Roll and own or occupy rateable property in the Shire of Harvey you may be eligible to enrol to vote. This applies if you were on the last electoral roll for the Shire of Harvey prior to May 1996 and have owned or occupied rateable property in the district continuously since this time. Please contact your local government for details. Owners of land who were on the last Local Government roll continue to retain that status until they cease to own the rateable property to which the enrolment relates. Occupiers do not have continuous enrolment and should contact the Shire of Harvey to confirm their enrolment status. To be eligible to enrol as an occupier, you will need to have a right of continuous occupation under a lease, tenancy agreement or other legal instrument for at least the next three months following the date of the application to enrol.

Joint Owners and Occupiers - If a rateable property is owned or occupied by more than two people, a majority of the owners/occupiers may nominate two persons from amongst themselves who are on either the State or Commonwealth Electoral Roll, to enrol as owner/occupier electors.

Corporations - A body corporate that owns or occupies rateable property may nominate two people who are on either the State or Commonwealth Electoral Roll to enrol as owner/occupier electors.

Binningup Coastal Rehabilitation

In April, the Shire of Harvey in partnership with the Binningup Coastcare and Environment Group successfully obtained \$25,000 in Coastwest funding for the Binningup Beach restoration.

The project aims to arrest dune erosion through the installation of sand fencing and revegetation, which will deter pedestrian access and generate sand deposition.

The rehabilitation works were completed last week. Sand fences have been constructed on the northern and southern end of the Main Swimming Beach with jute matting and brushing installed to assist in rebuilding the dunes and to keep people from entering the area. In addition, native seedlings have been planted amongst the dunes to help with rehabilitation.

Upcoming Work Young Street Partial Closure, Harvey

Western Power will be carrying out works involving the updating of conductors. This will require the partial closure of Young Street between Roy Street and Uduc Street. The northbound lane of Young Street will be closed on 1 September between 7am and 3pm with detours in place. Recreation and Cultural Centre users will need to access via Third Street - Sir James Avenue or through the Uduc Road gate.

Weed Spraying Program

As part of the Shire's maintenance program, turf weed spraying will commence throughout the Shire on 30 August 2021. Weed spraying will be undertaken in public open spaces and recreational areas in Treendale, Kingston, Galway Green and Lakeshore Estate. Works are expected to continue until 20 September 2021 (weather dependent), utilising an appropriate selective herbicide as per relevant Work Health and Safety legislation. Signage is always erected when works are being carried out and we ask residents to avoid the areas while they are being sprayed.
