#### 6.1 HRCC Budget 2021-2022 Update

Operational expenditure and income update: • Expenditure and Income both under budgeted levels to date. Income – childcare decreased numbers in both Holiday Program and After School Care. Committee recognize cyclical nature of this service. Group Fitness and yoga both decreasing numbers of participants. Also cyclical in nature.

Gym and Cultural events both above projected levels.

- Capital expenditure update Most gym equipment delivered. TV's mirrors, storage already in gym. Yoga / Karate room doors repaired 3 quotes received from builders for wall and ventilation improvements by Shire Building department. Big Ass Fans being installed in Court 1& 2; Court 3 next financial year. EWP – service completed, will be back at HRCC shortly.
- Workforce Update Isaac Stanford resigned effective 21 Jan 2022. Interviews for replacement conducted on 3/2/22. 30 hrs/fortnight PPT Recreation Officer Interviews for Casual Cultural officers resulted in 2 new staff: Melissa Plank Nadia Davis
