7.1 Shire Update

Office of the CEO

- Yarloop Workshops Redevelopment Project (YWRP).
 - 26 September 2023 Ordinary Council meeting approved alternative motion to:
 - award YWRP tender to Pennant Construction Pty Ltd (Pennant) to recommence and complete construction

- Give Local Public Notice of its intention to alter the purpose of the Yarloop Heritage Precinct Reserve and the Alcoa – Yarloop Townscape Reserve to include Funding of Yarloop Workshops and Men's Shed Construction
- Request Chief Executive Officer to assess the performance of Pennant Construction Pty Ltd and bring to the Council regular reports on the continuation of the Project with Pennant.
- Currently in process of engaging builder for early contract submission. If this submission is accepted Pennant will investigate works to be completed. The Shire will then discuss budgeted funds available to determine subsequent progress of contract.
- Christmas closure dates
 - Shire closed 22 December 2023 to 2 Jan 2024.

 - HRCC 24-hour gym open over Christmas period.
 - Skeleton staff over closure period.
 - Councillors available for community concerns https://www.harvey.wa.gov.au/shire/council/our-councillors
 - Rangers and parks and garden staff available during this period.
 - Call centre directing staff after hours.
 - Library opening hours:
 - Australind and Harvey libraries closed from 25 December 2023 and reopen Tuesday, 2 January 2024.
 - Binningup Library closed from 25 December 2023 and reopen Wednesday, 3 January 2024.
 - Yarloop Library closed from Tuesday, 19 December 2023 and reopen on Thursday, 1 February 2024. The community can access books/items from Yarloop CRC and/or Harvey Library during this time.
- Harvey Community precinct.
 - Kelly Beauglehole replacing Pauline Pietersen as Manager Special Projects leading this \$30m project.
 - The Shire has received the pre Tender estimate for the seven stages of work within precinct. Tender received is less than budgeted amount.

• Next stage is to work with lobbyist for private funding opportunities for Stage One and start preparing applications for State and Federal grant funding rounds in 2024.

Community and Lifestyle

- Yarloop Public School library mural
 - Arc Infrastructure informed Shire no location within proximity of rail corridor suitable for art project.
 - Six or seven possible locations identified.
 - Community consultation in early 2024 to identify artist and location.
 - A regional arts fund identified as possible funding source.
 - Artist Len Zuks has been approached to create a sculpture for the Yarloop township using recycled materials. Len's previous work can be seen here: https://www.aussietowns.com.au/town/boddington-wa
- o 2023-2024 Mural Program
 - Public Art Selection Panel recommendations for endorsement by LEAP.
 - LEAP members were presented the Selection Panel minutes and the preferred concepts. The group supports the preferred concepts as well as the promotional video concept to show community engagement in the installations.
 - Shire to engage artists to commence work early 2024.

Pile of wood Southwestern Highway

Private owner of property adjacent to Southwestern Highway has created a 10m firebreak around large woodpile.

Owner originally intended to reduce woodpile over winter but did not. Shire has communicated with owner fire risk concerns about pile which is located on private property.

Corella's in Yarloop

Discussion regarding Corella concern in Yarloop.

Shire member of collective of local governments who monitor and contract out Corella reduction measures.

Traditionally corella numbers are reduced when numbers exceed 200 in a location.

Action: Shire Officers to investigate Corella numbers on corner Railway Parade and Clifton Road area.

Teesdale street Yarloop

Discussion regarding Teesdale street and footpath flooding.

Discussed in Ordinary council with Director of Infrastructure aware of issue.

Further investigation ongoing with Teesdale street property owners to be consulted for most viable option to remedy.

Action: Shire Officers to investigate solution to Teesdale street flooding.
