Community feedback sought on Uduc Road London Plane Trees



The Shire of Harvey is exploring two options to address road impacts caused by London Plane trees on Uduc Road in Harvey.

London Plane trees are a distinctive feature of Harvey townsite. However, secondary root swelling is causing road damage and creating an uncomfortable drive through the main street.

Following the December 2025 Ordinary Council Meeting, the Shire is seeking feedback on two options.

Option 1

Retain the trees, but remove the secondary roots. This option will improve the road surface. The estimated cost is \$62,000 initially. Periodic removals will be required and that is estimated to cost \$30,000 for each occasion.

Option 2

Remove the trees completely. This requires a one-off cost, estimated to be \$20,000 for tree removal and \$100,000 for root removal and road repair.
