

# A look back at significant projects and initiatives delivered by the Shire of Harvey in 2024:

### **Harvey Skatepark**

Community members that like to "shred it" were given a new skatepark last April in Meriden Park, Harvey. Spearheaded by local youth, the project included installing a new pump track, park furniture, path network and fresh landscaping. The Shire is working on a plan to further transform Meriden Park into a hub for families and youth. Watch this space!

#### **Art Stop!**

Australind has been brightened up with five new art pieces! Last year, artists sent the Shire their artwork and a local committee selected their favourites to install on bus shelters. Other public art pieces completed in 2024 include murals at the Yarloop Library, Harvey-Myalup Road water tank, Brunswick Recreation Ground Entrance and the Christina Street Reserve amenities block.

#### Fees Field Dog Exercise Area

Local dogs were given more room to play after the opening of the Fees Field Dog Exercise Area last June. The new area is one of 11 places in the Harvey Region that are designated play areas for dogs. Fees Field sits near existing parking, seating, toilet facilities and water. The Shire is looking at putting another dog exercise area in Meriden Park, Harvey. Stay tuned!

#### **Community Grants**

Last year, 18 community groups were given a leg up by the Shire of Harvey's Community Grants Program.

Projects included installing solar panels at the Leschenault Men's Shed and supporting the 2024 Brunswick Show. The Community Grants Program will reopen Monday, 24 February 2025.

#### **RV Friendly Towns**

The Shire has transformed Harvey and Brunswick Junction into RV Friendly Towns. The Campervan and Motorhome Club of Australia (CMCA) will advertise local short stay parking bays to its 70,000 members and thousands of casual viewers. They will also provide the Shire with signage to promote the bays to travellers.

#### **Work in Progress**

The Shire has almost finished the Harvey Senior Citizen Centre expansion.

Meanwhile, the Brunswick River Cottages - Stage 3 project is expected to be finished in June.

The Yarloop Workshops Redevelopment - Stage 1 also restarted last year. The first stage is expected to be completed mid 2025.
