

DESIGN INTENT

- THE CAFE BUILDING HAS BEEN DESIGNED SO THAT IT ESTABLISHES AN ACTIVE RELATIONSHIP WITH ALL ACTIVITIES WHICH SURROUND IT AND THE WONDERFUL VISTAS THAT THE SITE OFFERS.
- THE DESIGN CREATES A SERIES OF 'PROJECTIONS' WHICH ADDRESS AND INTERACT WITH SURROUNDINGS. THE PRIMARY CAFE/RESTAURANT SPACE FACES THE ESTUARY TO THE WEST AND NORTH AND THE PLAYGROUND TO THE NORTHEAST. THE CAFE FUNCTION ROOM ALSO FACES THE ESTUARY BUT PROTRUDES TO THE SOUTH WEST. THE KIOSK ESTABLISHES AN ACTIVE LINK TO THE PLAYGROUND TO THE NORTH AND THE TOURISM SPACE FACES THE SOUTH EAST WHILE SHARING AN ENTRANCE FORECOURT WITH THE CAFE ON THE SOUTH. A WALL INTENDED TO EMBODY A PUBLIC ART WORK FOCUSSED ON LIFE IN AUSTRALIND FORMS A VISUAL WELCOME TO THE PRECINCT.
- A WIDE AND VIBRANT VERANDAH SPACE EXTENDS AROUND MOST OF THE BUILDING PROVIDING SEATING AND ALFRESCO DINING WHICH EMBRACES THE VAST VIEWS AND ENVIRONMENT OF THE SITE.
- . SERVICING FOR THE BUILDING IS DISCREET AND CENTRAL WITH DIRECT ACCESS TO THE CENTRAL KITCHEN AND SERVICES PROVIDING EXCELLENT EFFICIENCIES.
- . THE CENTRAL KITCHEN SPACE PROVIDES SERVICE FOR ALL PARTS OF THE CAFE INCLUDING ACCESS TO THE KIOSK.
- THE BUILDING PROVIDES TOILET FACILITIES FOR THE INTERIOR ACTIVITIES WHICH ARE ACCESSED INTERNALLY AS WELL AS PROVIDING FOR EXTERNAL USERS BY PROVIDING FACILITIES ABLE TO BE ACCESSED FROM EXTERNAL AREAS.
- THE BUILDING HAS EXCELLENT NORTHERN EXPOSURE AND WHILE VISTAS ARE MAINTAINED FROM THE NORTH TO THE WEST AND THE SOUTH THE DEPTH OF THE VERANDAHS PROVIDES SIGNIFICANT PROTECTION TO THE EXPANSE OF WINDOWS. THE EASTERN FACING FACADES ARE PREDOMINANTLY SOLID WALLS.
- MATERIALS ARE INTENDED TO FOCUS ON THEIR DURABILITY, ABILITY TO WITHSTAND THE SEVERE MARINE ENVIRONMENT, MINIMISE MAINTENANCE WHILE REFLECTING AN ELEGANT SIMPLE ARCHITECTURE MADE OF STEEL, GLASS, TIMBER SOFFITS, COLOURED CONCRETE REFLECTING THE SANDS OF THE COASTLINE AND COOL FRESH COLOURS OF THE COASTAL ENVIRONMENT.
