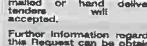

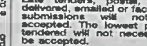

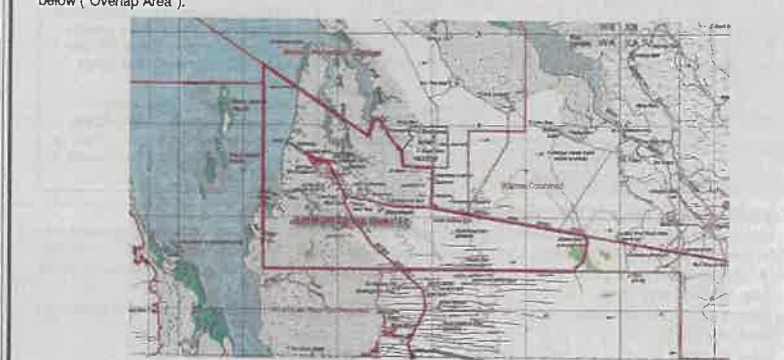

Who can attend the meeting: The meeting is being held for members of the Warrwa Combined native title claim, being the Aboriginal persons who are:

- the biological or adopted descendants of Topsy Mouwudjala; Gudayi and Bobby Ah Choo; or Nani; or
- recognised by the people in [1] as having traditional rights and interests in the area under traditional law and custom.

This meeting is about: considering whether to authorise the joint determination of native title over the Warrwa (WAD 33/2019) and Booroola Moorool Moorool (WAD 598/2016) native title claim area, as shown outlined in pink on the map below ("Overlap Area").



- What decisions will be made at the meeting?**
- Whether to authorise the terms of a joint consent determination of native title for the two native title claims over the Warrwa and BMM Overlap Area.
 - Whether to nominate a Prescribed Body Corporate to hold the native title rights and interests on trust, following the determination of native title in the Overlap Area.
