Local Government Act 1995

Waste Avoidance and Resource Recovery Act 2007

Under the powers conferred by the Local Government Act 1995, the Waste Avoidance and Resource Recovery Act 2007 and all other powers enabling them, the Council of the Shire of Donnybrook Balingup resolved to make the following local laws.

As resolved on 18 December 2024:

Shire of Donnybrook Balingup Waste Amendment Local Law 2024

The purpose of the local law amends the Shire of Donnybrook-Balingup Waste Local Law 2017 by replacing clause 2.1(1) to address drafting issues, and adding clause 5.1 that provides a right to object to and appeal a decision made under the local law.

The effect is that the Shire of Donnybrook-Balingup Waste Local Law 2017 is amended.

As resolved on 27 November 2024:

Shire of Donnybrook Balingup Animals, Environment and Nuisance Amendment Local Law 2024

The purpose of the local law amends the Shire of Donnybrook-Balingup Animals, Environment and Nuisance Local Law 2017 by deleting clause 3.10(b), and in clause 2.2(b) deleting the words 'or is' and replacing them with 'and is not'.

The effect is that the Shire of Donnybrook-Balingup Animals, Environment and Nuisance Local Law 2017 is amended.

These local laws come into operation on 26 August 2025, being 14 days after publication in the Western Australian Government Gazette on 12 August 2025. Both have been published on the Shire's website (www.donnybrook-balingup.wa.gov.au), and copies may be inspected at or obtained from the Shire Administration Office (1 Bentley St, Donnybrook, WA 6239).




