The Café provides a welcoming and supportive space where people living with memory loss conditions and their carers can connect with others in a relaxed environment.

The Australind pilot follows the success of the original pilot in Harvey, which recently transitioned from a Shire-led trial to a community supported program.

The Harvey Café will now continue under the stewardship of local resident Kathy Mitchell, who has stepped
