Throughout this experience, **participants** will be **introduced** to **Bindjareb Boodja** (also known as the Harvey Region).

The **first** Kaartdijin Dandjoo **program** is **Makuru** (wet season). This program **explores** Noongar **symbols** and **storytelling** through engaging and interactive activities. The **program** **encourages** cultural **understanding**, shared **learning** and stronger community **connections** for people of all ages and backgrounds.
