Why we are collecting your information

Your personal information is collected for the purpose of:

- investigating incidents of illegal camping
- managing complaints and enquiries relating to camping activities

How your information may be disclosed

Your personal information may be used and disclosed for the purposes outlined above.

The Shire may disclose personal information to:

- State Government agencies (e.g. Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions (DBCA), WA Police)
- State Government statutory authorities (e.g. Water Corporation)
- Local Government authorities
- contractors engaged by the Shire

Information may also be disclosed where authorised or required by law.

How we're authorised to collect your information

We collect, use and disclose your personal information in accordance with applicable laws, including:

- Caravan Parks and Camping Ground Regulations 1997
- Local Government Property Local Law 2017
- Activities in Thoroughfares and Public Places and Trading Local Law 2017

Consequences of not providing information

If you choose not to provide certain information, the Shire may be unable to:

- investigate complaints or incidents
- monitor or enforce compliance
